This minor prepares students to work in state, private, and federal forest-tree seedling nurseries with the production of conifer and hardwood bareroot and container seedlings used in reforestation programs throughout North America. Successful graduates of this minor will be knowledgeable in all aspects of seedling production from seed collection, sowing, and cultivation to irrigation, pest management, lifting, packing, storing, and outplanting. Along with seedling cultivation, students will also become familiar with the business aspect of running a forest-tree seedling nursery.
