What to expect!

ACES Field Internships are personalized to the student based on their major and interests, but some of the potential job duties include:

- Helping coordinate educational events and programs
- Participation in meetings on local issues
- Assisting with teaching youth or community educational programs
- Preparing for events and activities by researching, gathering materials, getting external support, and contacting participants
- Conducting field research, preparation of materials and translation of data for training of community members and extension personnel

*Internships may include developing or improving a project, process, or training tool that can be implemented in the host county/program area.

Agronomic Crops Aquatic Resources Farm & Agribusiness Management Forestry, Wildlife & Natural Resources Home Grounds, Gardens & Home Pests Animal Sciences & Forages Commercial Horticulture Food Safety & Quality Poultry

Q: What are the minimum qualifications for the internship?

- ✓ Must be currently enrolled in the Auburn University College of Agriculture or College of Forestry & Wildlife Sciences
- ✓ Minimum GPA of 2.8
- ✓ Sophomore year or above
- ✓ Excellent interpersonal and written communication skills
- ✓ Ability to problem solve independently

- Q: What is required to apply for this internship?
 - Submit an application online at <u>Auburn University Portal | AFNR-Field Summer Intern</u> (auemployment.com)
 - ✓ Positions will be posted under "Student Positions" you can search for Stu02968P
 - ✓ A current CV or resume and cover letter that includes areas of interest and 2-3 preferred counties is required
- Q: Will interns be paid?
 - ✓ Yes!! Interns will be paid \$15.00/hr (\$600 per week)
- Q: What hours will interns be working?
 - ✓ This is a full-time, 40 hours per week internship
- Q: What counties in Alabama are potential internship locations?

A: You can request any of the 67 counties in Alabama and we will do our best to place you with a field agent in that county based on your interests and major.
